162. On the other hand this process of response and growth is always preceded by God's gift, since the Lord first says: "Baptize them in the name..." (Mt 28:19). Eph 2:8-9; 1 Cor 4:7), enable that constant sanctification which pleases God and gives him glory. In this way, we allow ourselves to be transformed in Christ through a life lived "according to the Spirit" (Rom 8:5).
