**Sacrament of Reconciliation:** Confessions are heard every Saturday at Sacred Heart Church from 11:00am to 11:30am.

**Outdoor Mass:** Sacred Heart Parish is pleased to be opening our registration for the celebration of our Outdoor Mass. The Mass will take place on Sunday, July 25 at 11:00 am and we will be able to accommodate 200 guest in cohorts of 50. Things to remember: Call to Register 853-2344, bring your own chairs, bug spray and sunscreen, and check in with your group greeter upon arrival and from there you will be shown where to sit. There will be arrows to show you how to proceed for the Eucharist. If the weather is unfavourable we will have our regular scheduled Mass with Group B upstairs and Group D downstairs.
